There are several *CustomDB* templates in design and many others being contemplated such as Ophthalmology, Neurophysiology and Vascular medicine.

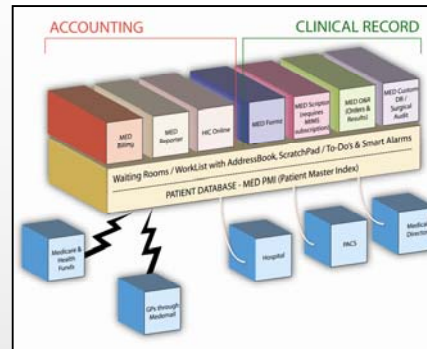
